Simbang Gabi



Our Parish Community will soon begin preparation of Simbang Gabi. Simbang Gabi Novena begins Wednesday, December 15 and ends Thursday, December 23.

Brief History: Simbang Gabi is a Philippine tradition of celebrating a novena of Advent masses to heighten the preparation of the faithful for the birth of our savior, Jesus Christ, and in honor of the Blessed Mother. This spiritual experience enables the faithful to joyfully anticipate the coming of the Messiah in their faith communities, home and hearts. Along with Holy Week and Easter, it is the highlight of liturgical life for the church in the Philippines. Traditionally, it takes place at dawn, 4-5am, starting on December 16th and ending with the Midnight Mass on December 24th.



In 2009, The SF Archdiocese has commissioned the celebration of Simbang Gabi. Through Simbang Gabi, the Church in San Francisco hopes to offer the faithful a deepening of spiritual experience that leads to a more meaningful Christmas season. It is also hope that this celebration will facilitate better sharing of faith and culture in the local parishes, thereby strengthening fellowship and family life in the community. The involvement of Filipinos and non-Filipinos in this experience is also expected to contribute to the development of leadership among the laity. This will also provide an opportunity for sharing and experiencing diverse religious expressions and cultural traditions.
